

What are 'Cookies'?

Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow it) that enables the site's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information.

They are also used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future.

We use cookies to compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may also use trusted third-party services that track this information on our behalf.

TYPES OF COOKIES USED

We use:

COOKIE NAME	What data is collected?
1P_JAR	Google uses these cookies, based on recent searches and interactions, to customise ads on Google websites
APISID	We use security cookies to authenticate users, prevent fraudulent use of login credentials, and protect user data from unauthorized parties.
CONSENT	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We may use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.
GMAIL_RTT	A cookie that relates to Google services (such as Google Maps or Gmail)
HSID	We use security cookies to authenticate users, prevent fraudulent use of login credentials, and protect user data from unauthorized parties
NID	These cookies are used by Google to store user preferences and information when viewing pages with Google maps on them.
SID	We use security cookies to authenticate users, prevent fraudulent use of login credentials, and protect user data from unauthorized parties.
SIDCC	We use security cookies to authenticate users, prevent fraudulent use of login credentials, and protect user data from unauthorized parties.

ANAGING AND DISABLING COOKIES

Most web browsers give you some control over cookies through the browser settings. However, turning cookies off may interfere with your browsing experience.

For instructions on how to manage and disable cookies, see the privacy and help documentation of your specific browser's website. If you use more Devices and/or browsers you will need to disable cookies on each Device and on each browser separately.
